

AN ORDINANCE TO PREVENT THE RUNNING AT LARGE OF DOGS AND / OR CATS, PROVIDING FOR THE DISPOSITION OF SAME, AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION OF THIS ORDINANCE, AND DECLARING THIS ORDINANCE AN EMERGENCY ACT, THE PUBLIC HEALTH AND WELFARE REQUIRING IT, AND EFFECTIVE AT ONCE. ordinance 111

SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF DUBACH, LOUISIANA, IN SPECIAL CALL SESSION convened, that it shall be unlawful for the owner of a dog or dogs and / or cat or cats to allow same to run at large within the corporate limits of the Town of Dubach, Louisiana.

SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, etc., that any person violating any of the provisions of Section 1 of this ordinance shall be guilty of an offence and upon conviction shall be fined not exceeding twenty-five (\$25.00) dollars, and in default of paying such fine be imprisoned not exceeding twenty-five (25) days.

SECTION 3. BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, etc., that it shall be the duty of the peace officers of the Town of Dubach, La., to kill by shooting, all such dogs and cats found running at large and destroy the carcass and or carcasses of said dogs and cats by burning with fire.

SECTION 4. BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, etc., THAT this ordinance is passed as an emergency ordinance, the public health and welfare requiring it, and shall become effective on and after midnight, April 29th 1939.

SECTION 5. BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, etc., THAT all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith, be and the same are hereby repealed.
