

AN ORDINANCE describing the property to be included within the corporate limits of the Town of Dubach, Louisiana, and defining the boundary of the corporate limits of said Town.

SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF DUBACH, LOUISIANA, in regular session conveyed, that there shall be included within the corporate limits of the Town of Dubach, Louisiana, the following described property, to-wit:

The West Half of the Northwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter ($W \frac{1}{2}$ of $NW \frac{1}{4}$ of $SW \frac{1}{4}$) and that portion of the West Half of Southwest Quarter of Southwest Quarter ($W \frac{1}{2}$ of $SW \frac{1}{4}$ of $SW \frac{1}{4}$) North of branch, which branch is the present city limits, all in Section 23, Township 20 North, Range 3 West, Lincoln Parish, Louisiana.

SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, etc., that the boundary of the corporate limits of the Town of Dubach shall be, and the same is hereby outlined, described and located as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at the Northwest Corner of the $NW \frac{1}{4}$ of $SW \frac{1}{4}$, Section 23, Township 20 North, Range 3 West, Lincoln Parish, Louisiana, and run South 990 feet, thence West 660 feet, thence South 330 feet, thence West 660 feet, to the Northwest Corner of the $SE \frac{1}{4}$ of $SE \frac{1}{4}$, Section 22, Township 20 North, Range 3 West, thence South 660 feet, thence West to the Northwest Corner of the $SE \frac{1}{4}$ of $SE \frac{1}{4}$ of $SW \frac{1}{4}$, Section 22, Township 20 North, Range 3 West, thence South 660 feet to the South Section Line of Section 22, Township 20 North, Range 3 West, thence West a distance of 660 feet, thence South a distance of approximately 1320 feet to the Southwest Corner of $NE \frac{1}{4}$ of $NW \frac{1}{4}$, Section 27, Township 20 North, Range 3 West, Lincoln Parish, Louisiana; thence East a distance of approximately 1700 feet to the Old Ruston Road, thence following said road in a Southeasterly direction to the C. R. I. & P. Railroad, thence in a Southwesterly direction along the East right-of-way line of said C. R. I. & P. Railroad to the North right-of-way line of the Memphis Natural Gas Co. pipe line; thence in a Southeasterly direction along the said East right-of-way line of said Memphis Natural Gas pipe line a distance of 2307 feet to the North right-of-way of

Southwest Gas pipe line leading to the Southwest Gas plant; thence East along the North right-of-way line of Southwest Gas pipe line a distance of 1700 feet; thence North to the North line of the NE 1/4 of SW 1/4, Section 26, Township 20 North, Range 3 West at the Southeast Corner of Old City Limits 210 feet East of NW Corner of the NE 1/4 of SW 1/4, Section 26, Township 20 North, Range 3 West, in the center of old road, thence Northeastly along the center line of said old road to where said road intersects the center line of the Dubach-Fellowship Highway; thence East and Northeastly along the center line of the Dubach-Fellowship Highway to a point where said road intersects the center line of the blacktop road leading from the extension of Winn Street to the Dubach-Fellowship Highway; thence Northeastly along the center line of said blacktop road to where said road intersects the C. R. I. & P. Railroad, thence Northeastly along the East right-of-way line of C. R. I. & P. Railroad to the branch, which is the present city limits of the Town of Dubach, Louisiana; thence in a Westerly direction along said branch to a point where said branch intersects the East line of the W 1/2 of SW 1/4 of SW 1/4; thence North to the North line of the NW 1/4 of SW 1/4, Section 23, Township 20 North, Range 3 West; thence West to the point of beginning a distance of approximately 660 feet.

SECTION 3. BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, etc., that all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith be and the same are hereby repealed.

This ordinance was read and considered by sections and as a whole, and upon being put to an official vote, it was adopted by the following YEA and NAY vote:
