AN ORDINANCE, LEVYING AND IMPOSING TAXES ON ALL PROPERTY SUBJECT TO TAXATION IN THE TOWN OF DUBACH, STATE OF LOUISIANA, FOR THE YEAR 1970.

SECTION I: BE ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF DUBACH, acting as the governing authority of siad Town, that a tax of twenty-four (24) Mills on the dollar of the assessed valuation of all the taxable property in the Town of Dubach, Louisiana, is hereby levied, assessed and imposed on all said property for the year 1970, seventeen (17) mills for the purpose of paying the principal of an interest on Public Improvement Bonds and Waterworks Improvement Bonds, and seven (7) mills imposed on said property for year 1970 for the purpose of General maintenance of the Town of Dubach, Louisiana.

SECTION II: BE FURTHER ORDAINED, etc., that the proper administrative officers of the Town of Dubach, Louisiana, be and they are hereby empowered, authorized and directed to spread said taxes, as herein above set forth upon the assessment roll of said Town for the year 1970 and to make collection of the taxes for and on behalf of said Town according to law, and that the taxes herein levied shall become ampermanent lein and privilege on all property subject to taxation as herein set forth, and the collection thereof shall be enforceable in the manner provided by law.

SECTION III: BE IT FURTHERMORE ORDAINED, etc., that this Ordinance shall be publised in the official minutes of the Mayor and Board of Aldermen in the manner provided by law.

This Ordinance having been submitted in writing, having been read and adopted by sections at a public meeting of said Mayor and Board of Aldermen, was then submitted to an official vote, the vote thereon being as follows: Yes: Marvin Fowler; Bobby Gene Colvin; Jesse W.
