

ORDINANCE NO. 153

NOVEMBER 16, 1981

AN ORDINANCE LEVYING A 1¢ SALES TAX UPON THE THE SALE AT RETAIL USE, RENT OR RENTAL CONSUMPTION, OR STORAGE OR USE OF CONSUMPTION OF TANGIBLE PERSONNEL PROPERTY, SALES OF SERVICES IN THE TOWN OF DUBACH, LOUISIANA.

SECTION A: THERE IS HEREBY LEVIED A TAX OF 1% OF THE RETAIL, THE USE, THE LEASE OR RENTAL, CONSUMPTION, STORAGE OR USE OR CONSUMPTION OF TANGIBLE PERSONNEL PROPERTY SALE OF SERVICES IN THE TOWN OF DUBACH, LOUISIANA. Define in Section 301 to 317, inconclusive of Title 47 of the Louisiana Revised statute. The Revenue derived from sales and use Tax shall be placed in the General Fund for The Town Of Dubach.

SECTION B: This Sales Tax is Levied in accordance in Section 2711-2715 of Title 33 of The Louisiana Revised Statutes and shall be collected and Distributed in Accordance with the Provisions there in.

SECTION C: This Tax shall be effective December 1, 1981 and shall be in addition to any other existing Taxes.

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ORDINANCE NO. 153

APRIL 12, 1971

AN ORDINANCE, LEVYING AND IMPOSING TAXES ON ALL PROPERTY SUBJECT TO TAXATION IN THE TOWN OF DUBACH, STATE OF LOUISIANA, FOR THE YEAR 1971.

SECTION I: BE ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF DUBACH, acting as the governing authority of said Town, that a tax of twenty-four (24) Mills on the dollar of the assessed valuation of all the taxable property in the Town of Dubach, Louisiana, is hereby levied, assessed and imposed on all said property for the year 1971, seventeen (17) mills for the purpose of paying the principal of an interest on Public Improvement Bonds and Waterworks Improvement Bonds, and seven (7) mills imposed on said property for year 1971 for the purpose of General Maintenance of the Town of Dubach, Louisiana.

SECTION II: BE FURTHER ORDAINED, etc., that the proper administrative officers of the Town of Dubach, Louisiana, be and they are hereby empowered, authorized and directed to spread said taxes, as herein above set forth upon the assessment roll of said Town for the year 1971 and to make collection of the taxes for and on behalf of said Town according to law, and that the taxes herein levied shall become a permanent lien and privilege on all property subject to taxation as herein set forth, and the collection thereof shall be enforceable in the manner provided by law.

SECTION III: BE IT FURTHERMORE ORDAINED, ETC., THAT THIS Ordinance shall be published in the official minutes of the Mayor and Board of Aldermen in the manner provided by law.

THIS ORDINANCE having been submitted in writing, having been read and adopted by sections at a public meeting of said Mayor and Board of Aldermen, was then submitted to an official vote, the vote thereon being as follows: YES: Marvin Fowler; Bobby G.
