

ORDINANCE NO. 155

AN ORDINANCE REVOKING THE DEDICATION OF A PORTION
OF AN ALLEYWAY IN BLOCK 5 OF THE TOWN OF DUBACH,
LOUISIANA.

WHEREAS, The Town of Dubach, Louisiana, is the owner of all streets
and alleyways as shown on the original plat of the town of record in Flat Book
1, page 24, of the records of Lincoln Parish, Louisiana, and,

WHEREAS, LSA-R.S. 48:701 provides, in part, that municipal corpora-
tions of the state may revoke and set aside the dedication of all roads,
streets, and alleyways laid out and dedicated to public use within their
respective limits, when the roads, streets, and alleyways have been abandoned
or are no longer needed for public purposes; and,

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Board of Alderman of the Town of Dubach,
Louisiana, have found that, in fact, the following described alleyway has
been abandoned and is no longer needed for public purposes, said alleyway
being described as follows.

That certain alleyway measuring 20 feet North and South by
140 feet East and West lying between the South line of Lot
3 and the North lines of Lots 5, 6, 7, 8 and 9 of Block 5
of the Town of Dubach, Louisiana, as per plat of the same of
record in Flat Book 1, page 24, of the records of Lincoln
Parish, Louisiana, and more fully described as beginning at
the Southwest corner of Lot 3 of Block 5 of the Town of Dubach,
Louisiana, as per plat of record in Flat Book 1, page 24, of
the records of Lincoln Parish, Louisiana, and thence run
south a distance of 20 feet to the Northwest corner of lot
5 of said Block 5; thence run East along the North lines of
Lots 5, 6, 7, 8 and 9 of said Block 5 a distance of 140 feet
to the Northeast Corner of Lot 9; thence run North a distance
of 20 feet to the Southeast corner of Lot 3; thence run
west along the South line of Lot 3 a distance of 140 feet to
the Southwest corner of Lot 3, being the point of beginning,
all being in Block 5 of the Town of Dubach, Louisiana, as
per plat of record in Flat Book 1, page 24, of the records
of Lincoln Parish, Louisiana,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Board of Aldermen
of the town of Dubach, Louisiana, in regular session convened, and acting as the
governing authority of said town.

SECTION 1. In accordance with the terms and provisions of LSA-R.S.
48:701. the dedication of the following described property for public purposes

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council
of the Town of Dubach, Louisiana, in regular session convened, and acting as the
governing authority of said town.

SECTION 1. In accordance with the terms and provisions of LSA-R.S.
§8.701, the dedication of the following described property for public purposes
as an alleyway is hereby revoked and set aside, said property being described
as follows, to-wit:

That certain alleyway measuring 20 feet North and South by
140 feet East and West lying between the South line of Lot
3 and the North lines of Lots 5, 6, 7, 8 and 9 of Block 5
of the Town of Dubach, Louisiana, as per plat of the same of
record in Plat Book 1, page 24, of the records of Lincoln

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Parish, Louisiana, and more fully described as beginning at the southwest corner of Lot 3 of Block 5 of the Town of Lubach, Louisiana, as per plat of record in Plat Book 1, page 24, of the records of Lincoln Parish, Louisiana, and thence run South a distance of 20 feet to the Northwest corner of lot 5 of said Block 5; thence run East along the North lines of Lots 5, 6, 7, 8 and 9 of said Block 5 a distance of 140 feet to the northeast corner of Lot 9; thence run North a distance of 20 feet to the Southeast corner of Lot 3; thence run west along the South line of Lot 3 a distance of 140 feet to the Southwest corner of Lot 3, being the point of beginning, all being in block 5 of the Town of Lubach, Louisiana, as per plat of record in Plat Book 1, page 24, of the records of Lincoln Parish, Louisiana,

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall not become effective until ten (10) days after its publication.
