

ORDINANCE NUMBER 15.

IN ORDER TO FURTHER AID IN MAINTENANCE OF STREETS ALLEYS AND PUBLIC HIGHWAYS IN THE TOWN OF DUBACH LA TO REQUIRE ALL ABLE BODIED MALE PERSONS BETWEEN THE AGES OF EIGHTEEN AND TWENTY FIFTY WHO RESIDE IN THE TOWN OF DUBACH LA FOR MORE THAN TEN DAYS TO PREFORM WORK UPON SAID STREETS ALLEYS AND PUBLIC HIGHWAYS IN THE TOWN OF DUBACH LA AND FIXING PENALTY FOR VI OLATION OF THIS ORDINANCE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and the Board of Aldermen of the Town of Dubach La in regular session convened: That every able bodied male person between the ages of Eighteen and Fif- ty years residing in the Town of Dubach La for more than ten days, shall be subject to and required to ~~perform~~ perform work on the Streets, Alleys and Public Highways in the Town of Dubach La for a period of not more than one day during each quarter of the calender year said person or persons residing in the Town of Dubach La.

Section Number 2.

Be it further ordained and ets, that the Marshall, Street Commissioner or any one in charge of the Street work of the Town of Dubach La shall notify in person or writing twenty four hours before the streets alleys and public highways are to be worked, each person subject to street duty as provided for in Section 1 of this ordinance, of the time and place said work shall begin, and each person so notified shall meet at the time and place stated in said ~~order~~ notice for the purpose of working on the streets, alleys and public highways of the Town of Dubach La.

Section 3.

Be it further ordained and etz, that any person subject to street duty as provided for in Sec 1 of this ordinance shall have the right to pay the Marshall or Street Commissioner or other officers in charge of said work \$1.00, per quarter for each calender year in lieu of performing work on the strets as herein provided and the receipt of the Marshall Street Commissioner or other officer in charge of the Street work shall exempt any person from street duty.

Section 4.

Be it further ordained and etc, That any person violating this ordinance shall be fined in the sum not less than \$2.50 nor more than \$20.00 or imprisioned not less than five days npr more than thirty at the discretion of the Mayor
