

ORDINANCE NUMBER 16.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and the Board of Aldermen of the Town of Dubach La in regular session convened: That it shall be unlawful for any ~~person~~ stock, such as horses and cows, hogs, sheep and goats to run at large within the incorporate limits of the Town of Dubach La.

Section No 2.

That it shall be the duty of the Marshall, when such stock is at large and complaint is made to him, to notify the owner of said stock to take up said stock at once: and upon his refusal to do so, the Marshall shall at once take possession of said stock and pen them in a place prepared by the ~~owner~~ town: the owner to pay all charges of whatever kind.

Section Number 3.

That for each violation of this act, the owner shall pay Fifty Cents (.50¢) for each horse, .25¢ for each cow, sheep, goat and hogs that may be taken up, and an additional .25¢ per day for each head such stock is kept up and this money paid to the Marshall to be paid to the Town Treasurer and become a part of the Towns funds.

Section 4.

That at the expiration of Five (5) days where the owner has been notified, and refuses to pay such charges and takes possession of said stock, the Marshall shall on the following day at 10 o'clock A.M. at the place of keeping said stock, sell to the last and highest bidder said stock, proceeds to go as in Section 3 this act.
