

**Minutes of the Town of Dubach Board of Alderman
Regular Monthly Meeting
Tuesday, February 21, 2023**

Regular Monthly Meeting was called to order by Mayor Mona Wilson at 6:30 pm. Present were the following council members: Dunn, Moerbe, Roberts, Billberry, and Graham. A quorum was present.

Invocation was led by Billberry.

Pledge of Allegiance was conducted in unison.

Adoption of Agenda Motion was made by Billberry and seconded by Graham to adopt the agenda. Motion carried.

Adoption of the Previous Minutes Roberts motioned to accept previous minutes from 1/4/2023 – 2/3/2023. Graham seconded. Motion passed.

Adoption of the January 2023 Financials Moerbe suggested that we list the purposes for multiple deposits in the General Fund. Mayor Wilson stated those are due to bulk deposits for that specific day, but we will make a note of it. Moerbe also inquired about multiple AT&T payments for the month and asked could they be consolidated into one payment. Mayor Wilson stated there should be two per month, but December bills did not get paid. Motion carried.

Resolution 407-002 – to add Shekenna Nathan to bank records as clerk. Motion was made by Graham to add Shekenna to the bank records as clerk. Roberts seconded. Motion passed.

Keep Louisiana Beautiful Grant Mayor Wilson informed the council that 10 trash cans have been ordered. They will all have a “Let Louisiana Shine” tag placed on them. Ten spots around town have been allocated and will be maintained by the town. Motion carried.

Note to pay for valve replacement on water tank Mayor Wilson stated the water tank has been leaking for about ten days and needs to be changed. Estimates have been provided from three different companies for material and labor. Installation is included. Water/Sewer fund will be used for this project. Motion carried.

April 22nd – Love the Boot – Keep Dubach Beautiful Cleanup Day (10:00 AM – Town Hall) Mayor Wilson informed the council that the cleanup day will be on April 22nd at 10:00 AM. Also, she wants the school to participate in the event on Friday, April 21st.

Public Comments Debbie suggested all Aldermen and the Mayor wear a name tag at town events. The public inquired about zoning ideas. Mayor Wilson stated that replacing the town clerk and town finances were top priority this month but will have an update for next meeting. A letter was sent to Nancy Green to repair her building. The public inquired about the town’s presentation regarding hoarding. Mayor Wilson informed the public they will soon be able to direct all complaints to the town’s website.

Mayor Comments The 2nd Annual Easter Egg Hunt will be on April 1st. She thanked everyone for coming out and is looking forward to everyone coming to next month’s meeting.

Council Comments Graham informed the public that they are welcomed to voice their concerns before the monthly meeting so that the appropriate actions can be taken.

Adjournment was made by Roberts and seconded by Dunn. Motioned carried at 7:10 pm.
