

**Minutes of the Town of Dubach Board of Alderman  
Regular Monthly Meeting  
Tuesday, February 22, 2022**

**Regular Monthly Meeting** was called to order by Mayor Mona Wilson at 6:30 pm. Present were the following council members: Billberry, Dunn, Graham, Moerbe, and Roberts. A quorum was present.

**Invocation** was led by Billberry.

**Pledge of Allegiance** was conducted in unison.

**Adoption of Agenda** Motion was made by Graham and seconded by Roberts to adopt the agenda. Motion carried.

**Adoption of the Previous Minutes** Dunn motioned to accept previous minutes from 01/18/2021. Graham seconded. Motion passed unanimously.

**Adoption of the January 2022 Financials** Motion was made by Graham and seconded by Roberts to adopt the January 2022 financials. Motion carried unanimously.

**Wynn Street Apartment Hearing** After much discussion between mayor and council, Attorney Breedlove (via phone), and Attorney Daigs, motion was made by Graham and seconded by Roberts to grant Wynn Street Apartments owners until May 31, 2022 to perform the recommended repairs to Buildings 1 & 3 outlined in the structural engineering report and a review meeting thereafter at the following council meeting. Motion passed unanimously.

**Dilapidated Homes, Blight, and Abandoned Vehicles (Update)** Mayor Wilson informed the council the old Jr Food Mart property owner is cleaning the property and removing the building.

**ARPA Funds** Motion was made by Moerbe and seconded by Billberry to allow the town to use \$ 14,400 of ARPA funds to purchase fiber internet service through AT&T. Motion carried. Motion was also made by Graham and seconded by Roberts to allow the town to purchase the \$ 600 PA system from Entertainment etc. Motion carried.

**Public Comments** Maggie Brown informed the council the dilapidated and junk car ordinances set in place hold more authority than what council may perceive.

**Mayor Comments** Informed council and audience about our 1<sup>st</sup> annual Easter Egg Drop on Saturday, April 16 and about the town joining in with the state clean up efforts called "Dubach: Team Up to Clean Up" on Saturday, April 23.
