ORDINANCE #200

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE HOLDING OF MUNICIPAL
ELECTIONS AT THE SAME TIME AS CONGRESSIONAL ELECTIONS

WHEREAS, by Act 829 of the Regular Session of the Louisiana Legislature of 1983, LA. R.S. 33:383 was amended and re:enacted to provide that by ordinance the governing authority of any municipality may adopt a plan for holding municipal elections at the congressional elections in accordance with R.S. 18:402 (B), AND THEREFORE

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mavor and Board of Aldermen of the Town of Dubach, Lincoln Parish, Louisiana that in accordance with LA. R.S. 33:383, that municipal elections for the various elected officials for the Town of Dubach shall be held at the same time as congressional elections in accordance with R.S. 18:402 (B). The present term of all elected officials to the Town of Dubach shall be extended through December 31, 1986 and the first municipal elections under this plan shall be at the 1986 Congressional Elections. Elected officials shall take office on the first day of January following said election and shall hold their office for four years.

The above and foregoing having been read section by section and as a whole was offered by Murel Graham, seconded by J. T. Rogers and the vote was as follows:
