

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE IMPOSITION OF COURT COST RESULTING FROM THE TRIALS IN MAYOR'S COURT IN THE TOWN OF DUBACH, LOUISIANA.

Section I: Be it ordained by the Board of Aldermen of the Town of Dubach that the Mayor of the Town of Dubach in his capacity as Judge of the Mayor's Court, may impose court costs not to exceed \$30.00 for each offense by a defendant convicted of a violation of a municipal ordinance.

Section II: The court cost, as provided in the next preceding paragraph, shall be in addition to fines or imprisonment imposed for the violation of the municipal ordinance.

Section III: Be it further ordained that this ordinance shall be published in the official minutes of the Mayor and the Board of Aldermen in the manner provided by law.

Section IV: This ordinance shall become effective as provided by R.S. 33:406(E).^{FNI}
