AN ORDINANCE, LEVYING AND IMPOSING ON ALL PROPERTY SUBJECT TO TAXATION IN THE TOWN OF DUBACH, STATE OF LOUISIANA FOR THE YEAR 1991.

SECTION I: BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF DUBACH, acting as the governing authority of said Town, that tax of Seven Point Two (7.2) Mills on the dollar of the assessed valuation of all the taxable property in the Town of Dubach, Louisiana, is hereby levied, assessed and imposed on all said property for the year 1991. The Seven Point Two (7.2)Mills imposed on said property is for the maintenance of the Town of Dubach, Louisiana.

SECTION II: BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, etc., that the proper administrative officers of the Town of Dubach, Louisiana be and they are hereby empowered, authorized and directed to spread said taxes, as herein above set forth upon the assessment roll of said Town for the year 1991 and to make collection of the taxes for and on behalf of said Town according to law, and that the taxes herein levied shall become a permanent lien and privilege on all property subject to taxation as herein set forth, and the collection there of shall be enforceable in the manner provided by law.

SECTION III: BE IT FURTHERMORE ORDAINED, etc., that this Ordinance shall be published in the official Minutes of the Mayor and Board of Aldermen in the manner provided by law.
