

Ordinance # 24

REGULATING THE BUILDING OF OUT-DOOR TOILETS IN THE TOWN OF DUBACH, LOUISIANA.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the Town of Dubach, Louisiana, in regular session convened: That it shall be unlawful for any person or persons to erect or have erected within the corporate limits of the Town of Dubach, Louisiana, any open or surface toilet or any other toilet which does not conform to the specifications of the Louisiana State Board of Health.

Section 2. Be it further ordained and so forth that any person or persons who shall violate this ordinance shall be subject to a fine of not more than \$25.00 and not less than \$5.00 and all costs and in default of payment thereof shall be forced to work not less than ten days or more than thirty days on the streets of the Town of Dubach, Louisiana.
