Minutes of the Town of Dubach Board of Alderman Regular Meeting Monday, May 15, 2023

Regular Call Meeting was called to order by Mayor Mona Wilson at 6:30 pm. Present were the following council members: Moerbe, Billberry, and Graham. A quorum was present.

Invocation was led by Graham.

Pledge of Allegiance was conducted in unison.

Adoption of Agenda Motion was made by Moerbe and seconded by Billberry to adopt the agenda. Motion carried.

Adoption of the Previous Minutes Moerbe motioned to accept previous minutes from 4/17/2023. Graham seconded. Motion passed.

Adoption of the April 2023 Financials Moerbe motioned to accept April 2023 financials. Billberry seconded.

Randy Rogers – Dubach Legends Mr. Rogers shared ideas with the council to improve some areas around the park, as well as offered to purchase two new flags for the town. These improvements include a new fishing and kayaking dock, a new fountain off the pavilion, and the repair and reconfiguration of the pavilion. He also pitched the idea of hosting events including, but not limited to open air concerts. Mr. Rogers informed the council that these projects will be funded by the Dubach Legend Fund. This fund was created specifically to make Dubach a place that people want to visit. Mr. Rogers stated that anyone is able to contribute to this fund if they desire.

Public Comments After Mr. Rogers' presentation, the townspeople voiced concerns of alligators being in the pond. Mayor stated that multiple alligators have been pulled from the pond, but is unsure if all of them are out.

Mayor Comments Mayor Wilson informed the council of the success of the bake sale held on May 13th. The town was able to raise \$380 to go into the town's donations for events in the future. She also informed every one of the plans to update the playground in July 2023.

Council Comments Councilman Moerbe asked Mayor Wilson if the ARPA Fund could be used to help with the repairs around the park and the baseball park? Mayor stated that the funds can be used and also informed the council of the grant received from the Community Foundation of North Louisiana for the beautification efforts and ballpark improvements. She also informed the council half of the money will go to the cost of the boat dock and the other half to the ballpark.
