

ORDINANCE NUMBER 5.

REQUIRING ALL STORES SHOPS GROCERIES AND ALL PLACES OF PUBLIC BUSINESS EXCEPT THOSE HEREIN EXEMPTED TO BE CLOSED ON SUNDAYS AND FORBIDDING ALL GIVING TRADING BARTERING OR SELLING ON SUNDAYS BY PROPRIETORS OR EMPLOYEES OF SUCH ESTABLISHMENTS AND FIXING THE PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION OF SAME.

Section Number 1.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the Town of Dubach La in regular session convened: That all stores, shops and places of public business are hereby required to ~~close~~ be closed at 12 o'clock Saturday night and remain closed continually 24 hours during which period of time it shall not be ~~unlawful~~ lawful for proprietors thereof or employees to trade, barter, exchange or sell any of the stock or any article of merchandise kept in ~~an~~ any such establishment, unless actual necessity requires it.

Section Number 2.

That whoever shall violate the provisions of this ordinance shall pay a fine of not more than \$25.00 and in default of payment not more than thirty days of imprisonment or both fine and imprisonment at the discretion of the Mayor.

Section Number 3.

That the provisions of this ordinance shall not apply to printing offices, book stores, drug stores, apothecary shops, undertaking shops, public and private markets, bakeries, dairies, livery stables, railroads, hotels, boarding houses, warehouses for receiving and forwarding freight, restaurants, ice factories, telegraph and telephone offices, news dealers, keepers of soda fountains, nor prevent the sale of ice, providing that stores may be opened for the purpose of selling anything for sickness or burial purposes, providing that nothing in this ordinance shall be construed so as to allow drug stores to dispose other than drugs and medicines, provided restaurants and other exempted place shall not ~~sell~~ sell articles of merchandise not exempted.

This ordinance adopted by sections to take effect from and after its passage, vote on adoption, YEAS Dr J.L. Smith, R.L. Cox. C.C. Fuller Clerk and J.J. Fuller Mayor.
